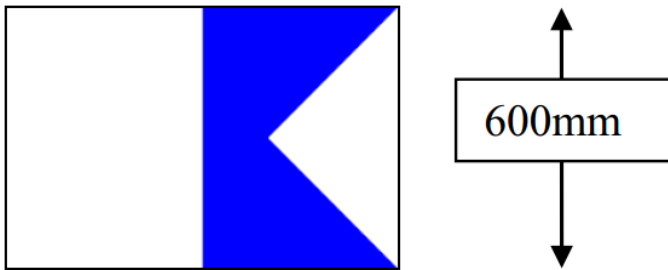

For any dive vessel going within 50m of a ship or wharf, all personnel on board the dive vessel must have completed a Southern Ports induction and hold a port access card. Diving operation are not to be conducted within 100m of any ships unless under direct written approval by the Harbour Master.

Section 2: Notification of Harbour Master (to be completed by Harbour Master)

Approval from the **Harbour Master** must be sought on **(08) 9072 3344** or **0417 922 501** at **least 24 hours before any diving activity within the port area**. The Harbour Master is to be notified immediately prior to divers entering the water and immediate on the completion of that day's dive, by either VHF CH16 or on the mobile number.

Divers must keep a continual watch on VHF CH12 and CH16 and display an International code flag A at all times.



If the vessel is working under the wharf, a rigid version of the flag must be displayed on the wharf and be visible from Seaward.
