SOUTHERN PORTS AUTHORITY, PORT OF ESPERANCE LOCAL MARINE NOTICE 05/2022.

PASSAGE PLANS

Local Marine Notices 04/2021 and 01/2020 are cancelled.

Masters are advised of the requirement under SOLAS Chapter V annex 24 Voyage Planning "The Plan covers the voyage from berth to berth and therefore includes the Pilotage stage".

The Port Authorities Act 1999 S104 (1) (b) and S108 provides:

"a harbour master may direct the ... master... of a vessel ...to navigate the vessel in a specified manner while it is in the port

Penalty: \$20 000"

The pilotage manoeuvre will not commence until the pilot has confirmed:

- The vessel's passage plan waypoints are the same as those herein provided.
- The provided waypoints are to be entered into the vessel's ECDIS or marked on the vessel's charts if the vessel is using paper charts.
